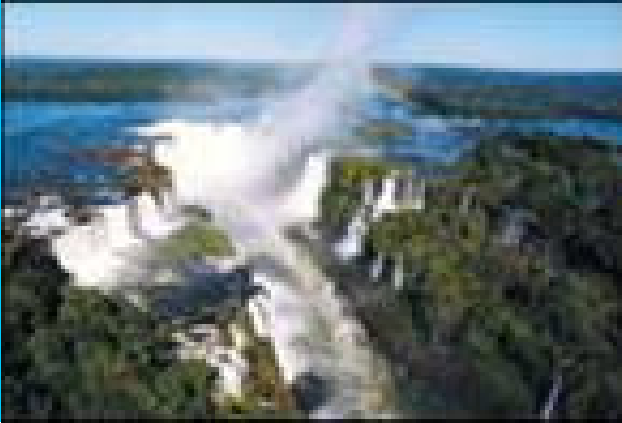

Iguassu Falls



The State of Paraná is privileged in having two of the Brazilian and most interesting tourist attractions in the world: one of them is at one side, where Iguazu National Park is located, a protected environmental area, housing the Iguazu Falls, a spectacular group of 275 waterfalls; and on the other side, we can find Itaipu, the largest hydroelectric power plant in the world. Iguazu Falls belong to three different countries: Brazil, Argentina and Paraguay. And the main cities around the area are Foz de Iguazu (Brazil), Ciudad del Este (Paraguay) and Puerto Iguazu (Argentina). Visitors can buy duty free imported goods in Ciudad del Este, as well as typical Paraguayan handicraft.
